The types of activities the Roundtable might undertake, given adequate resources, include coordinating monitoring efforts, participating in the preparation of a plan for the watershed, sponsoring educational events, or working towards consensus on issues that affect the watershed.

The Roundtable will gain credibility through its actions over time and become an important voice in support of a healthy watershed. One of the objectives of the Roundtable is to reduce conflict and facilitate decision-making based on shared values in the best interests of the watershed.

The Roundtable will not have authority to make decisions that are the jurisdictional or legislative responsibility of governments or the legal responsibility of any other entity that is participating in the Roundtable. Governments and government agencies will participate, but the Roundtable will be an independent entity, not under government direction. Guided by a Core Committee, representing the many watershed sectors of interest, public Roundtable meetings will be held at least twice each calendar year: spring and fall, as resources permit.
