

Storm Drain Marking Challenge

**Did you know that ALL drains lead to
fish habitat?**

- In urban areas, storm drains on paved streets and parking lots collect rainwater runoff
- Runoff that drains into storm drains contains sediments, animal waste, oil, swimming pool water, and toxic household or industrial compounds AND does not go into the domestic sewage system
- Storm drains empty this untreated runoff into nearby waterways impacting fish habitat

For the month of July you can help by participating in the 4th annual **Storm Drain Marking Challenge**, presented by Langley Environmental Partners Society (LEPS). Participants will be challenged to mark multiple storm drains with the iconic yellow fish that alerts the community that all drains lead to fish habitat.
