




... timely and appropriate topic!

1. Complex issues involving multiple interests.


3. Four levels of government involved.




Multiple groups (partnerships or a team)

"collaboration" Without communication



The Three Spheres of Sustainability






PSF's Role in Collaboration within & for the Fraser
