

A user survey was conducted in the post-season of 2011 to record feedback regarding the pilot DATA MANAGEMENT ADVISOR position, filled by the UFFCA and A'Tlegay Fisheries Society with funding from the Fraser Salmon and Watersheds Program (FSWP).

Survey respondents include data technicians working in First Nation fisheries offices, such as the Carrier-Sekani Tribal Council, Tsilqotin National Government, Nazko First Nation, and others that were provided ongoing in- and post-season technical support in the use of the FSC DATABASE for storage and reporting of the FSC fisheries data.

The sample size of 5 respondents is too small for analysis, but the combined results indicate:

- the FSC Database is a very important tool for FN fisheries data management;
- weekly DMA assistance was routinely requested and provided in-season;
- the DMA (Sarah Hood) received high ratings for technical expertise and responsiveness;
- the DMA position played an important role in achieving FN data management goals;
- computer workshops and technical assistance were valuable and should be repeated in 2012.
