

Methodology



Method

Canadian online survey via Leger's LEO panel, with n= 1,001 BC residents aged 18+.

When

In field from September 12 - 14, 2025, inclusive.

Margin of error

For comparison purposes, a probability sample of n=1,001 yields a margin of error no greater than $\pm 3.1\%$, (19 times out of 20).

Weighting

Incidence weighting was completed by gender, age, region, education, and language, based on Statistics Canada data.




Detailed Results



Support for Government Investment in Rebuilding Wild Pacific Salmon Populations

Support for government investment in rebuilding wild Pacific salmon populations is widespread, with more than 4 in 5 BC residents in favour and nearly half expressing strong support. Overall support is highest among higher-income households (\$80K+), while rural residents and those aged 55+ are more likely to strongly support it.

SUBGROUP DIFFERENCES

Strong support is higher among BC residents

- → Who live in rural areas (57%)
- → And aged 55+ (52%)

Overall support is higher among BC residents with an income of \$80+ (86%)
