It is our pleasure to extend an invitation for you to enter the 2027/2028 Salmon Conservation Stamp Art Competition.

This year marks the 39th annual Salmon Conservation Stamp Art Competition and the winning image will be selected to produce the 2027/2028 stamp. Fisheries and Oceans Canada issue the Salmon Conservation Stamp, which is purchased and affixed to the license of tidal water anglers who wish to retain any species of salmon.

Please read through the enclosed rules and regulations carefully. We hope to make it clear that we encourage and welcome representational images such as First Nations art and that not all entries will include traditional habitat backgrounds. Please note that the winning artist may not enter the competition for two years following the year that they win the competition. Also of note, PSF is not responsible for any brokerage fees or customs charges.
